

**Jack, Ava and Lukas love going to Westleigh Methodist Primary School.**




# What happens when I get to school?

**“Hello children,” says the teacher. “We have lots of exciting things to do today.”**




# What happens when I get to school?

**Are you looking forward to coming to school?**




# What will I do in school?



**You will learn and do lots of fun things at school. Jack and Ava choose to go play outside. They put on their waterproof coats and wellington boots and play in the mud kitchen.**




**At school, you are allowed to play out in all weathers – sun, rain and snow!**

Ava is having a banana. "Yum, my favourite. I peeled it myself," she says.




# What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?


# What happens if I need the toilet?

“Thank you for asking so nicely.”




# What happens if I need the toilet?
